- 4. Rough draft get it all out and don't worry
- 5. <u>Main body paragraph must have's these are your 8 sentences for each main body paragraph:</u>
 - a. Topic sentence
 - b. Main detail #1 on this topic
 - c. Example/evidence
 - d. Main detail #2 on this topic
 - e. Example/evidence
 - f. Main detail #3 on this topic
 - g. Example/Evidence
 - h. Concluding sentence
- 6. Main body paragraph things to think about including, if not at first then during your edit:
 - a. Vocabulary
 - b. Adjectives describing, identifying, or quantifying words. An adjective usually precedes the noun or the pronoun which it modifies.
 - i. The **truck-shaped** balloon floated over the treetops.
 - ii. Mrs. Morrison papered her **kitchen** walls with **hideous** wall paper.
 - iii. The small boat foundered on the wine dark sea.
 - iv. The coal mines are dark and dank.
 - c. Does it have eight sentences?
 - d. Did you include any figurative language (simile, metaphor, assonance, alliteration, oxymoron's, etc)

- 8. Hand in rough draft for Tanya to edit
